



TRICKBOARD USER MANUAL

Please read this manual and safety information before use.

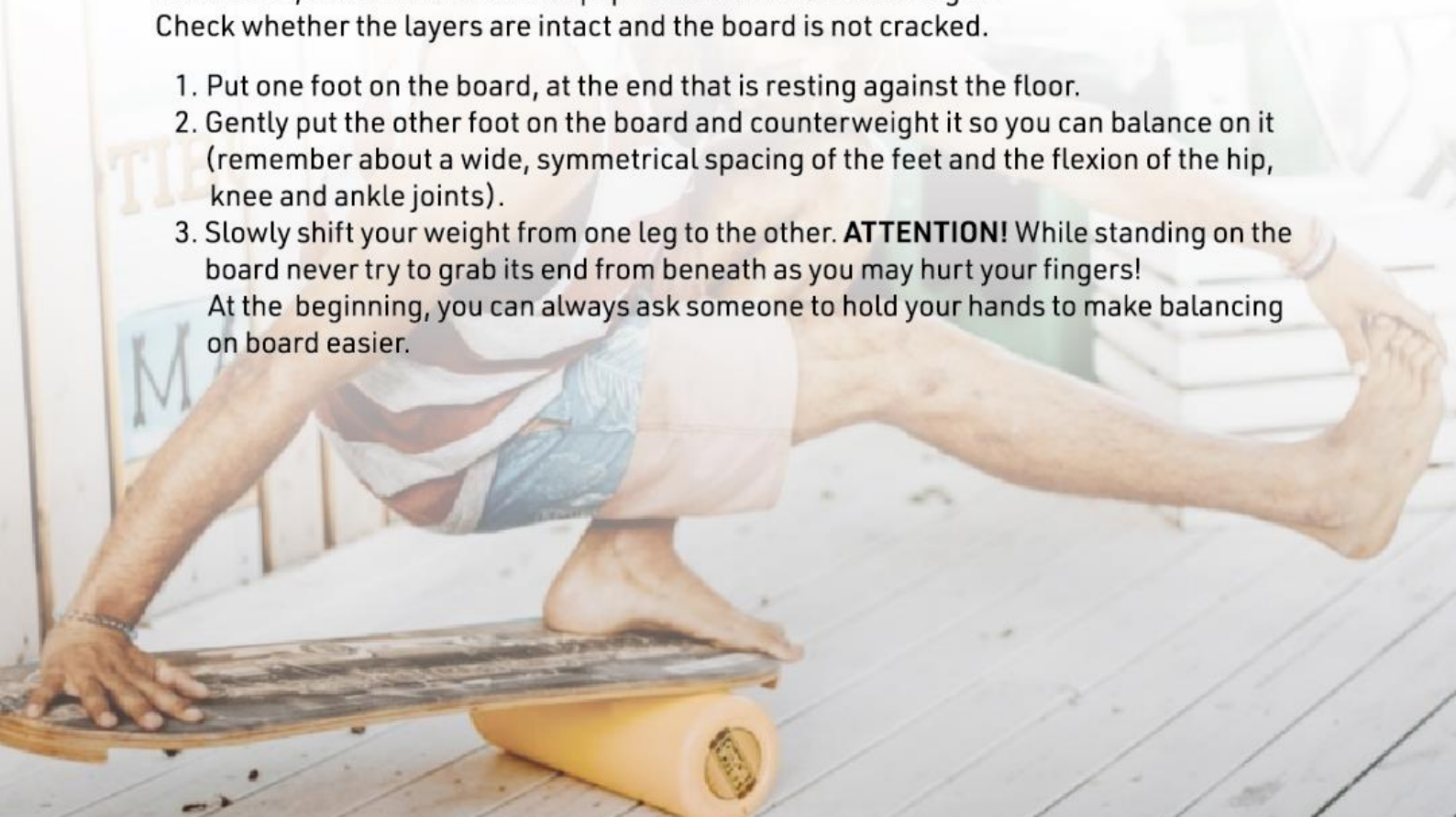
Safety information:

1. To use Trickboard, choose safe spaces away from furniture (table, bench etc.) and other unstable objects. It is best to practice on a non-slip mat. Avoid wet, slippery, and uneven surfaces as they may result in a fall. We recommend our original Trick board non-slip mat 200/110 cm.
It is recommended to practice within the range of the board and non-slip mat. The board is not suitable for use on the beach (in the sand) and when it's raining. Exercising on the balancing board may be unsafe.
2. Always wear a helmet, as well as elbow pads, knee pads and wrist protectors.
3. Learn everything slowly and with caution. If you lose balance, don't wait till you fall, jump off Trickboard.
4. Children under 18 years old should use Trickboard only in presence of an adult and while being safeguarded by them.
5. Beginners should practice in the presence of adults or more experienced peers, while retaining a safe distance from other people (2 meters minimum).
6. Maximum weight of a Trickboard user is 120 kg.
7. Please remember: you are using Trickboard at your own risk. The use of a damaged board is prohibited. In case of any damage the board needs to be repaired to prevent injuries.

Advice for beginners:

Before use, make sure that the equipment has not been damaged. Check whether the layers are intact and the board is not cracked.

1. Put one foot on the board, at the end that is resting against the floor.
2. Gently put the other foot on the board and counterweight it so you can balance on it (remember about a wide, symmetrical spacing of the feet and the flexion of the hip, knee and ankle joints).
3. Slowly shift your weight from one leg to the other. **ATTENTION!** While standing on the board never try to grab its end from beneath as you may hurt your fingers!
At the beginning, you can always ask someone to hold your hands to make balancing on board easier.



4. The board is only suitable for one person at a time! It is forbidden to exercise under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
5. The most common injury associated with Trickboard use is a fall on the arm. In case of sustaining such injury please report to the nearest medical facility.

Trickboard: MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY

LETS BOARD guarantees Consumers that the products covered by this warranty are free from material, production and design defects. The warranty is granted to end product users, hereinafter referred to as Consumers, i.e. entities who purchased the product to meet their own needs and have not purchased the product for resale or for the purpose of their own professional or economic activity. All defects that occur during the warranty period should be reported to the seller in writing. The defect should be reported in writing no later than 2 weeks from its detection. Proof of purchase needs to be presented along with the report, with the proviso that if necessary, LET'S BOARD reserves the right to establish the warranty start date as the date of product manufacture. The report needs to contain a detailed description of the found defect and the circumstances of its finding, as well as photographic documentation, if needed.

LETS BOARD

may, at its own discretion, fix the faulty product, exchange it, or issue a refund within 30 days (from the date of complaint receipt). In case the Guarantor decides to replace the faulty product with a product free from defects, of the same kind, quality and model and at the time of reporting the defect, the product is no longer being manufactured, LET'S BOARD reserves the right to deliver a product of parameters similar to the faulty product.

The warranty does not cover:

Damage resulting from improper storage conditions of the board and the roller. The roller may not be subjected to long-term sunlight exposure as it may get damaged. The board is not waterproof. The use of board on sand may cause the non-slip surface to wear off. In case the deck board is worn out, contact the manufacturer for service.
